DAY 01 — PROVERBS 1:7

The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge: but fools despise wisdom and instruction.

DAY 02 — PROVERBS 2:6

For the LORD giveth wisdom: out of his mouth cometh knowledge and understanding.

DAY 03 — PROVERBS 3:5

Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding.

DAY 04 — PROVERBS 4:23

Keep thy heart with all diligence; for out of it are the issues of life.

DAY 05 — PROVERBS 5:21

For the ways of man are before the eyes of the LORD, and he pondereth all his goings.

DAY 06 — PROVERBS 6:23

For the commandment is a lamp; and the law is light; and reproofs of instruction are the way of life.

DAY 07 — PROVERBS 7:2
